~ Give Darfurians a voice on the SDC website~

Save Darfur Canada (SDC) is a not-for-profit national coalition of organizations advocating for the Canadian government to play a greater role in ending the crisis in Darfur, Sudan.

Our operating model distributes responsibility and leadership among a dynamic and always evolving team. The success of SDC depends in large part on the hard work and enthusiasm of interns and coordinators who are often un-paid. New interns will have the opportunity to take on increasingly greater leadership and responsibility within the organization.

SDC's vision is to create a place on its website where viewers can learn about the Darfur crisis through the visual and written accounts of Darfuris and other Sudanese or regional commentators. The valuable work of the Multimedia Resource intern will help to develop a section of the website that examines the crisis from the perspective of those living in the midst of it or those who have witnessed it. The exact role of the Multimedia Resource intern in creating the final product will depend on qualifications and experience.

Application deadline:	Position will be removed from the website as soon as it is filled
Start and end dates:	Begins immediately; minimum of 8 consecutive weeks
Hourly commitment:	A minimum of 40 hours needed to complete the project; the project could be expanded and improved if the applicant is able to devote a greater number of hours
Location:	SDC office in Montréal
Remuneration:	Volunteer position (Please note this position can be treated as an internship for school credit if approved by the institution attended.)

Main responsibilities

- Researching video, audio, and images produced by or featuring Darfuris for inclusion on the SDC site
- Taking part in the team creation of an educational/informative section on the SDC website that will highlight Darfuri and Sudanese perspectives on the crisis
- Obtaining permission to display these media accounts on the SDC website
- Analyzing all media for possible controversial topics and maintaining a summary log
- Liaising with other multimedia team members
- Performing a few selected interviews (pending the availability of funding, multimedia equipment, and technical support)

Qualifications

- Good research skills in a variety of media
- Good organizational skills and attention to detail
- Ability to work independently with limited supervision
- Strong communication skills in English and/or French
- Experience with Publisher or other web layout software is an asset but not required
- Experience with video editing and converting is an asset but not required
- Background knowledge of the Darfur crisis is an asset but is not necessarily required
