

## Technical Support Intern

*Save Darfur Canada (SDC) is a not-for-profit national coalition of organizations advocating for the Canadian government to play a greater role in ending the crisis in Darfur, Sudan.*

*Our operating model distributes responsibility and leadership among a dynamic and always evolving team. This position covers a variety of tasks such as providing general technical support, discussing and resolving technical challenges as they arise, recommending and/or making improvements to SDC's current technical systems, and being involved in the start-up of new media and multimedia teams.

***The main responsibilities of this intern position will depend on the qualifications and experience of the interested candidate.***

**Start and end dates:** Begins immediately; position length depends on the level of involvement chosen by the candidate

**Hourly commitment:** A minimum of 2 hours per week; ideally 4-5 hours per week

**Location:** SDC office in Montréal

**Remuneration:** Volunteer position (Please note this position can be treated as an internship for school credit if approved by the institution attended.)
