

Website Programming Intern

Save Darfur Canada (SDC) is a not-for-profit national coalition of organizations advocating for the Canadian government to play a greater role in ending the crisis in Darfur, Sudan.

The main responsibilities of this intern position will depend on the programming skills of the interested candidate.

Application deadline: Position will be removed from the website as soon as it is filled

Start and end dates: Begins immediately; position length is concurrent with the level of involvement chosen by the candidate

Hourly commitment: Depends on project

Location: Montréal or anywhere in Canada

Remuneration: Volunteer position (Please note this position can be treated as an internship for school credit if approved by the institution attended.)

You can either provide a link to a sample of your work online or include a screenshot in the application package. You can expect to receive a response within two weeks of submitting your application package.
